

2015-16 RTI General Scholarship Guidelines

Revised May 4, 2015

1.0 Description

- 1.1 The RTI General Scholarship is need-based and is awarded to students who are in good academic standing.
- 1.2 Amount: RTI General Scholarship awards vary according to student need and availability of funds, with awards generally in amounts of \$50 and \$100 per student per month.
- 1.3 2015-16 Funding Period: Students will receive scholarships from September 2015 to August 2016.
- 1.4 Renewal: Students who are awarded an RTI General Scholarship for 2015-16 are eligible to apply for renewal of their scholarship for the 2016-17 school year.
- 1.5 Number of Scholarships: The total number of individual financial awards for 2015-16 will be determined by the amount of available funds.
- 1.6 Funding Designation: RTI General Scholarships are applied directly to RTI tuition and fees.

2.0 Eligibility

- 2.1 All RTI students are eligible to apply for scholarships.
- 2.2 Maintaining Eligibility: Students who are awarded the RTI General scholarship must demonstrate on-going academic and ministry competency. Academic and ministry competencies are reviewed by Academic Dean, RTI Coordinator, adjunct faculty, and Ministry Practicum supervisors at the end of each term to determine on-going eligibility.
- 2.3 Withdrawing from RTI: Students who withdraw from school will automatically lose their scholarship. Students who are re-admitted to RTI after withdrawing may re-apply for a General Scholarship after successfully completing one term of course work.

3.0 Application Process

- 3.1 Information packets will be available on the RTI webpage under Current Students by **Tuesday, May 5, 2015**.
- 3.2 Personal Information: The application process requires students and their families (dependents only) to submit relevant personal information.
- 3.3 Application Due Date: Applications for the RTI General Scholarship are due by **Monday, June 8, 2015**.
- 3.4 Notification: Students will be notified of scholarship decisions by **Wednesday, July 1, 2015**, for the 2015-16 school year.

4.0 Evaluation Process

- 4.1 Financial need is evaluated by the RTI Scholarship Committee based on personal financial information submitted by students.
- 4.2 Academic standing is assessed by RTI staff and faculty. Students must be in good academic standing to qualify for a scholarship.
- 4.3 The RTI Scholarship Committee makes the final determination of scholarship awards.
