Communicate

Stay in touch with missionary's joys, victories, difficulties, and concerns.

Cultivate

Help the church body to understand and value the ministry of the missionary.

Coordinate

Be a team of encouragers and prayer partners to care for the missionary throughout the entire mission life-cycle: pre-field, in-field, and post-field.

Collaborate

Work together with others to nurture your missionaries as they serve.
