INTRO

While many of us probably haven't been to the Burning Man festival that Efrain described, we have been to other events and experiences that have been life changing.

What event, festival, camp experience, etc has made a significant impact on your life?
And why?

IDEA 1 - A SACRED TEXT TO ENCOUNTER

Efrain shared that "If we are honest, we no longer approach the Bible as a sacred text to encounter but merely as a textbook to be examined"

and

"We must recapture the Bible as more than a historical artifact, a source of knowledge or moral guidance—it is a living encounter with the God of the universe"

- What do you think Efrain means by "the Bible...a sacred text to encounter?"
- Why do you think these days we are more likely to approach the Bible as a textbook to be examined than a sacred text to encounter God?
- What has been your experience with encountering God through Scripture? How would you describe this experience?
- What questions do you have about encountering God through Scripture?

IDEA 2- PUTTING IT INTO PRACTICE

Later in his sermon, Efrain explains that "in order to experience the power of God's Word it must travel outside the pages into our everyday life"

- Why do you think in order to experience the power of God's word we must put it into practice in our everyday lives?
- How do you think we can keep ourselves from becoming like the people Efrain described at his academic paper presentation - experts in the Bible but immature in their application of it?
- What does it look like for our life group to not only talk about the sermon and God's word but promote putting it into practice?

EXPERIENCING GOD TOGETHER: LECTIO DIVINA

Choose one of the scriptures below from the sermon and engage with it using the practice of Lectio Devina.

- Heb 4:12-13
- James 1:22-25
- Acts 2:42-47

As a reminder, here are the 4 movements of Lectio Divina

- 1. Read the Scripture slowly. What words or phrases is the Holy Spirit impressing on me?
- 2. **Read the Scripture again.** How is God communicating to me through the words in this passage? What about it resonates with me at this moment?
- 3. **Respond to God after reading**. What is my response to God based on how he has spoken?
- 4. **Rest in God's presence.** How is God capturing my attention for deeper union with Him?
