IDEA 1: THE POWER OF JESUS BRINGS PEACE TO OUR PAIN

Take time together to review Mark 4:35-41.

As we observe Jesus' power over chaos, how does this bring hope to places of chaos in your life and in the world around us?

Consider these two statements that Brian made:

Jesus uses His power on our behalf - because He loves us. He is fiercely compassionate - His power brings peace to our pain.

Sometimes our obedience to Jesus leads us into a storm, which seems counterintuitive and makes us question our obedience.

How can these both be true at the same time?

How have you experienced or witnessed both of these spiritual realities?

IDEA 2: WHAT IS THE PEACE OF JESUS?

The peace of Jesus is:

- wholeness
- hope
- restoration of community

As Brian reviewed these stories with us, what stuck out to you?
